Before your admission

Thank you for choosing Anglesea Hospital. Your specialist will book your procedure with Anglesea Hospital and arrange the date of your admission. You will be given an admission form. The admission form is required to be completed and returned to Anglesea Hospital at least three working days prior to surgery.

Please contact your insurance company to seek prior approval for your surgery and to clarify what is covered under your policy.

Please note:

- Time for admission - you will either be given a time by your specialist or the Pre-admission Nurse will phone you prior to surgery date
- Nothing to eat or drink for at least six hours prior to your procedure. This includes chewing gum. You may drink plain water up to two hours prior
- Transport arrangements should be made with a friend or relative to drive you home after surgery. You must not drive yourself home or use public transport
- You should avoid alcohol, cigarettes and drugs (except those prescribed by your doctor) for 24 hours before and after your anaesthesia
- Should you develop any illness e.g. cough, cold or skin infection please contact your doctor or Anglesea Hospital as it may be necessary to postpone your procedure

What to bring

- X-rays, scans or test results
- Current medication including herbal and natural remedies
- Doctor's letters and reports
- Insurance prior approval letter
- Glasses/ hearing aid
- Comfortable loose clothing

Please do not bring any jewellery or valuables as we do not accept responsibility for their safe keeping.

Children having surgery

Your child's comfort and well-being are important to us and visiting the Hospital before admission to familiarise you both with the surroundings is recommended.

We encourage parents and caregivers to stay with their child and you may like to bring in a favourite toy and any special items that assist in comforting them. We recommend that if possible you do not bring other children with you.

Post-operative care

We value your feedback. If you have a compliment, comment or complaint please let our staff know at any time during or following your procedure.

After the procedure you will be offered light refreshments and given adequate time to recuperate before dressing and returning home.

Before you leave, the specialist and nurses will advise you of what to expect as you recover. You will be given an information sheet with discharge instructions and follow-up doctor's appointment.

It is recommended that during the first 24 hours following your procedure you should:

- Have a responsible adult to stay with you overnight
- Not drive a motor vehicle
- Not make any important decisions or sign important documents
- Not be the primary child carer

Within a few days following your discharge one of our nursing staff will contact you to see how you are and to answer any questions.
